

CHANGES, ADDITIONS, DELETIONS IN THE PARENT/STUDENT HANDBOOK
(Effective – August 19, 2009)

1. Page 18-19 – **Attendance** – Chronic or excessive absences, without substantial cause can be a factor in determining a student’s continued enrollment in the school. (Archdiocesan Policy #4201) If a child is absent due to a doctor’s visit, then a doctor’s slip is needed when the child returns to school. If a child is absent three or more consecutive days, the child must present a doctor’s slip upon returning to school. If excessive absences warrant it, a mandatory parent meeting will be required.
2. Page 26 - **Socks** - Socks MUST be **WHITE or NAVY**; they must be visible. Pre-stitched athletic emblems are allowed.
3. Page 26 - **Belts** - Belts must be worn with all pants and shorts. **Belts must be solid black, brown, or navy.** Belts are a part of the school uniform; if students do not wear a belt, they will have consequences to pay for not abiding by the school code.
4. Page 27 - **Girls Basic Uniform** - Skirts, jumpers, shorts, culottes may not be more than 3 inches above the knee.
5. Page 27 - **Personal Appearance** – Hair (boys and girls) should be on one’s natural color. Hair should be kept out of the student’s face. **Boy’s hair must be off the eyebrows, off the shirt collar, no longer than mid-ear.**
