I also need consent by a parent/ legal guardian to be able to administer the medication. Attached is a sample form that can be used for your physician to fill out. I can accept a fax order from your doctor. I am sorry for any inconvenience this may cause, but it is for the safety of your children's health.

**PLEASE DO NOT SEND ANY LOOSE MEDICATION TO SCHOOL IN A BAGGIE!** All medication needs to be sent to school in an original container or box.
